Tenure Track Position – The Division of International Relations

The School of Political Science at the University of Haifa invites applications for a tenure track position in International Relations beginning 1 October 2017. The position is open to individuals at all stages of their career, but candidates must have their Ph.D. by October 2017. Candidates whose focus includes International Political Economy, area studies other than the Middle East, and research methods are especially welcome to apply. Faculty are expected to achieve proficiency in Hebrew within two to three years of hiring.

Please submit a letter of application and CV, including list of publications. Highly qualified candidates will be asked to provide additional materials (letters of reference and a sample of published work). Final decisions, including assignment of rank, are subject to resource availability, consideration of the Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences and the final decision of the Rector (Provost).

Successful candidates will be expected to teach courses in Hebrew within a few years of their arrival.
